

High Card Flush is a suits based game where the objective is to obtain multiple cards in the same suit (Flush). It's simple to learn, fun to play and includes multiple opportunities to win. Players are dealt seven cards to make their best Flush hand to play against the dealer's best Flush hand. Players must place the Ante wager and any additional side bets to begin the game. Additional side bets include the Flush and Straight Flush wagers. After all initial wagers are made, both the player and the dealer each receive seven cards. Players may choose to raise up to 3x their Ante. If a player has at least five cards of the same suit, they can raise up to 3x their Ante. If a player has at least six cards of the same suit, they can raise up to 3x their Ante. The best Flush hand wins (Flush Only) and any side bets are reconciled.

HOW TO PLAY

SIDE BETS

Flush – wins odds if the player's hand contains a Flush. Straight Flush – wins odds if the player's hand contains a Straight Flush.

FLUSH BONUS PAYTABLE

7 Card 300 to 1 5 Card 10 to 1 6 Card 100 to 1 4 Card 1 to 1

STRAIGHT FLUSH BONUS PAYTABLE

7 Card 8000 to 1 5 Card 100 to 1 3 Card 7 to 1

6 Card 1000 to 1 4 Card 60 to 1

Ante Wager Win when your Flush is higher than the Dealer, or if the Dealer doesn't qualify.

Raise Wager Raise wager or fold. Make up to 3x your Ante wager, depending upon your Flush. The better your hand, the more you can wager (Dealer must qualify to win).

Flush Wager Compare your Flush to the paytable for great odds.

Straight Flush Wager Win big with a Straight Flush. The larger the Straight Flush, the more you win!

The Flush and Straight Flush wagers are independent of the outcome of the Ante and Raise.
